Subject of Review: This report documents the methods used to produce the United States Department of Agriculture (USDA) Economic Resource Service (ERS) forecasts of farm-level average net cash farm income and farm household level median and mean income. These forecasts are released three times a year and provide information on the financial well-being of farms and the households that operate them. These financial indicators' historical components use data from the Agricultural Resources Management Survey (ARMS) drawn from a representative cross-section of farms across 48 states. The forecast components are produced by the models discussed in this report. The models start with micro-level data from ARMS and use the USDA-ERS net cash farm income forecasts and other economy-wide forecasts to simulate changes in two income categories: farm operation income and other farm household income. Summary statistics, including average net cash farm income by farm size and type, are then reported in the ERS's Farm Income and Wealth Statistics and Farm Household Income and Characteristics data products.
