Subject of Review:	In the United States, wheat ranks third in planted acreage, production, and cash receipts among field crops, following corn and soybeans. The market situation for wheat producers has been on a trajectory driven by declining U.S. domestic per capita wheat consumption and greater export competition. The result has been moderate declines in planted acreage, production, and exports over the past several decades. To address risks faced by wheat producers, U.S. farm legislation offers risk management tools. Title I includes programs like Price Loss Coverage and Agriculture Risk Coverage, providing potential government payments. Additionally, Marketing Assistance Loans support producers. Title XI focuses on crop insurance, subsidizing premiums to protect against yield or revenue declines. This report outlines U.S. wheat market developments, highlights legislative programs from the 2018 farm bill, and assesses their impact on supporting wheat producers—offering stakeholders in the agricultural realm perspectives on these issues. While future legislation remains uncertain, discussions center on adjusting parameters to existing programs.
