Subject of Review: The agricultural economy experienced pronounced volatility over the past decade, including strong periods of expansion in the first part of the decade followed by several years of contraction. Although many financial indicators, including sector and household income, do not indicate elevated stress and are now at or near their long-term average, certain sub-sectors and certain farm households do show elevated stress, and states have elevated bankruptcy rates. We use a variety of sources to explore the drivers and trends faced by the sector, including USDA administrative data as well as data collected from farm operations and farm households and data from the U.S. Courts. The charts and analysis aim to help readers judge the severity of the farm sector downturn and better understand the needs of financially distressed farmers.
