Subject of Review:	The COVID-19 pandemic induced significant changes in where and what foods were purchased in the United States. Research suggests that prior economic shocks have had long-term impacts on food consumption patterns, diet and health-related outcomes and exacerbated existing disparities in these outcomes across socioeconomic groups. However, the pandemic and its recovery differed importantly from these other economic shocks and the long-term diet and health impacts are unclear. This report examines whether these shifts persisted after vaccines were rolled out in 2021–2022 and if they persisted similarly across socioeconomic groups.
