Subject of Review: Irrigation organizations comprise several different governance structures. At one extreme, community organizations such as acequias in New Mexico work together to maintain ditches and deliver water. At the other extreme, U.S. Bureau of Indian Affairs irrigation projects maintain and operate storage and conveyance infrastructure to deliver water to users. Groundwater organizations focus on coordinating groundwater extraction and conserving water for future use. Some of these organizations are structured to allow users to have input into their operations through voting. Some organizations are structured as non-profits. The governance structures of irrigation organizations are shaped by the historical context in which they were created, and those differences are reflected in their acreage, member farm composition, infrastructure characteristics, and water use.
